Official,

As you may know from the material I have sent you on earlier occasions that the State is cheating on how it counts cases of Covid-19 and even the test they use is unreliable and many of the included cases are not tested at all. But regardless of these facts the mass media continues to insist there is a real spike once again in cases which will require a renewed lockdown.

I no longer care about the number of cases there are as the definition of a pandemic has no numerical threshold for the beginning or ending. Therefore, a pandemic can exist as long as an official says it exists regardless of the numbers involved. But I do not have authority to make my neighbors do that. Hence, I cannot delegate authority to the State to make anyone or everyone do those things regardless of the existence, severity, and prevalence of Covid-19 or any other disease. Authority does not come to the State via emergencies or pandemics. Since my authority did not increase with the appearance of Covid-19, neither can the State's authority increase. The exercise of power without authority is defined as

tyranny. And that means the State Covid-19 Restrictions are tyrannous and should not be enforced.

It is apparent that the State and Federal government are intent on keeping these Covid Lockdown Restrictions, which are harmful to the health and economy of all citizens, in place until we submit to vaccines and digital implants to verify that we are no longer a threat to the health of society. The use of harm (real, threatened or pretended) to alter public policy or law is defined as terrorism.
