Re: Six Step Plan to stop Covid-19

President Biden,

I saw your announcement of your six step plan to stop the "Covid-19 pandemic." It was apparent that you are not familiar with the limits of authority of the people or the governments they create. Article 4 Section 4 of the US Constitution says:

"The United States shall guarantee to every State in this Union a Republican Form of Government, and shall protect each of them against Invasion; and on Application of the Legislature, or of the Executive (when the Legislature cannot be convened) against domestic Violence."

Article 1 Section 2 of the Texas Constitution is pretty clear about what a republic is:

"All political power is inherent in the people, and all free governments are founded on their authority, and instituted for their benefit. The faith of the people of Texas stands pledged to the preservation of a republican form of government, and, subject to this limitation only, they have at all times the inalienable right to alter, reform or abolish their government in such manner as they may think expedient."

Therefore if we are to make and maintain a free government anywhere in the cosmos, federal or state, and I doubt our founders had any other intention, we must not only create or establish government on the authority of the people but that government can never exceed the authority of the people at any time after its founding. It is obvious that this statement is the essence of a republic anywhere in the cosmos. The use of the word *people* applies to each individual and not to a majority of individuals as John Locke in his Second Treatise of Government expressed so well:

"Though the Legislative, whether placed in one or more, whether it be always in being, or only by intervals, tho' it be the Supream Power in every Commonwealth; yet, First, It is not, nor can possibly be absolutely Arbitrary over the Lives and Fortunes of the People. **For it being but the joint power of every Member of the Society given up to that Person, or Assembly, which is Legislator, it can be no more than those persons had in a State of Nature before they enter'd into Society, and gave up to the Community. For no Body can transfer to another more power than he has in himself;** and no Body has

an absolute Arbitrary Power over himself, or over any other, to destroy his own life, or take away the Life or Property of another....Their Power (Legislative) in the utmost Bounds of it, is limited to the publick good of the Society. It is a Power, that hath no other end but the preservation, and therefore can never have a right to destroy, enslave, or designedly to impoverish the Subjects."¹

The above quote is not idle chatter of just any political philosopher but one upon whom Thomas Jefferson said was the source of all American ideas of human liberty upon which our governments were based. This proves that Article 1 Section 2 of the Texas Constitution is about government being limited to the authority that is in each individual not in a majority of the individuals which is still limited to that in each individual. A majority of individuals does not increase the authority of any individual. A majority can elect office holders but it cannot transfer more authority to government than any one individual possesses.

You have said that the decision to take or refuse the vaccines and boosters is not about freedom or personal choice but rather saving your own life and the life of others. But I will illustrate the real issue as follows: I have a right, in order to avoid a virus, to wear a mask at all times, stay home, close my business, reopen my business in stages, and take one or more vaccines, but I do not have a right to tell or compel my neighbor to do those things for any reason including a pandemic. As a result, I cannot delegate an authority I do not possess to government. Therefore, the State of Texas, defined as a republic in Art 1 Sec 2, can never obtain authority to tell, compel or coerce any one person or all people to do those things. This illustration is based upon the ancient *natural law of delegated authority* that says no one can delegate more authority to another than they hold in themselves as Locke used in the quote above. This law is adopted in the meaning of Article 1 Section 2 and is the sole foundation of all authority of the State of Texas limited to that which is in each individual and no more.

I have demonstrated this to Governor Abbott in Texas and I believe he has responded pretty well and stopped all his unlawful mandates and remains firm against them. But now you are claiming he and governors like him are undermining the Covid recovery efforts and you are trying to impose these unlawful mandates upon the people of Texas in violation of Article 4 Section 4 of the US Constitution. You are trampling our republic not guaranteeing it! Just because a business hires 100 or more employees does not give you authority to destroy our republic in Texas!

The essence of this controversy is not about my rights and freedom as you have well said but rather about rights and freedoms individuals do not possess and cannot delegate to any government anywhere including Texas or the federal government or any representatives of either. The want of rights and liberties in myself and my fellow citizens denies authority to government. No citizen in Texas has more authority than I do as also expressed in Article 1 Section 3 of the Texas Constitution.

The exercise of power without authority is tyranny by definition, hence, it is no exaggeration to say that all these Covid-19 mandates, including the vaccine requirements, are tyrannous and those that impose them are tyrants. It would be unwise to dismiss this
